#### **Best Places to Visit in Illinois**

Looking for a road-trip but not wanting to go to far? Here are some of the best places to visit right here in Illinois!

- 1. **Anderson Japanese Gardens** *Rockford* (12-acre sanctuary with waterfalls, tea house, ornate bridges, and rock gardens)
- 2.Starved Rock State Park, *Utica* or Matthiessen State Park Lake Falls, *Utica* or Buffalo Rock State Park, *Ottawa*
- 3. **Burden Falls- Shawnee National Forest**, *Stonefort* (one of the highest waterfalls in Illinois)
- 4. **Gross Point Lighthouse**, *Evanston* (national landmark 1873, 141 steps to top of the tower)
- 5. **Great River Road**, *Galena to Cairo* (550 miles along the Western edge with river, woodlands and small Midwestern towns)
- 6. **Fabyan Windmill at Fabyan Forest Preserve**, *Geneva* (68ft, five story windmill)
- 7. **Cahokia Mounds**, *Collinsville* (2,200 acre site is Illinois' one-and-only United Nations World Heritage Site)
- 8. **Garden of the Gods- Shawnee National Forest**, *Herod* (rock formations, Camel Rock, Anvil Rock, and Devil's Smoke Stack)
- 9. Nicholas Conservatory & Gardens, Rockford (Sinnissippi Rose Gardens, and tropical plant-life indoors)
- 10. Spoon River Valley Scenic Drive, Canton (tree-lined road enjoy in the fall with the changing colors 100 miles)
- 11.**Grand View Drive**, *Peoria* (2.52 miles of Illinois River Valley-in 1910 Teddy Roosevelt called "the world's most beautiful drive")
- 12. **Mississippi Palisades State Park**, *Savanna* (15 miles of trails with dramatic cliffs, limestone caves, and wooded ravines)
- 13. **Chicago Botanic Gardens**, *Glencoe* (385 acres with 6 miles of shoreline, waterfalls, Japanese and English walled gardens, a model railroad garden, and a Bonsai collection)

## Farm Safety Tips

- Discuss safety concerns with children and co-workers, explain safe handling and operating procedures.
- Store farm chemicals securely where kids and animals can't access them.
   Also make a list of chemicals for firefighters in the event of a fire on the property.
- Prohibit riders on tractor fenders, hitches, attachments, or implements.
- Conduct regular equipment inspections, as this act can prevent farm-related injuries by identifying problems and hazards early.
- Outfit tractors and farm trucks with fire extinguishers and first aid kits.
- Ensure all headlights, flashing warning lights and turn signals are in good working order.
- Have a Slow Moving Vehicle (SMV) emblem on your equipment.
- Be prepared and expect the unexpected when traveling to your next farm!
